## **2019 Tenerife “Palo Blanco” Envínate**

### ***Cheese & Charcuterie Selection***

*From the centenarian vines in the black volcanic soil of Teide in the Orotava Valley comes this wild white. Strongly mineral to taste with hints of yellow fruit, citrus and cut grass followed by an oaky finish. The fermentation takes place spontaneously using only indigenous yeast in oak casks for 10 months. Paired with a board of French cheeses and Spanish cold meats.*

## **2018 Hermitage, Etienne Guigal**

### ***Smoked Salmon***

*A white wine from Château D’Ampuis in the heart of Côte-Rôtie, Northern Rhône. With aromas of white flowers, quince and acacia honey, and a hint of elegant and delicate oak, the finish is slightly spicy with a touch of vanilla and toasted almonds. Perfect alongside our Smoked Salmon*

## **2018 Pinot Noir ‘Gran Morrairie’ Yamhill-Carlton**

### ***Seared Tuna***

*This red wine from Oregon has aromas of cherry, raspberry, and cedar. Soft and fresh, silky tannins with an elegant earthiness, it has a juicy acidity with a fantastic backbone structure. The perfect pairing for a Seared Tuna with Bok choy, shiitake mushrooms & Asian broth.*

## **2015 Château Grand Corbin Grand Cru**

### ***Slow Roasted Lamb Shoulder***

*A deep red from Saint-Émilion, Bordeaux. This cuvée wants to express all its fragrant sophistication with hints of spice, pepper and raspberry on the bouquet. Elegant on the palate, the silky tannins and its fruity aroma are adorned with floral notes. The finish is savoury and spicy and there is no better dish to pair it with than our slow roasted, lamb shoulder, with white beans stew and spring greens.*

## **1995 Brunello di Montalcino Riserva, Marchesato**

### ***Rib Eye Steak***

*One of Italy’s most prestigious wines, a complex red from Montalcino, in Tuscany. A thick wine with a powerful tannin structure that requires at least 20 years of ageing. Once the tannins have been allowed to melt, this rich and complex wine develops smoky and spicy notes. On the palate the wine is incredibly fruity, with velvety, dense tannins giving off scents of red roses, sweet tobacco and brandied cherries. Perfect to pair with prime cuts of beef, rocket and fries.*
